The conference celebrates the **70**th **anniversary of the Georgian National Academy of Sciences and the 120**th **birthday anniversary of its first President, Academician N. Muskhelishvili.** It is supported by the Georgian government and its organizers include the Ministry of Education and Science of Georgia, the Georgian National Academy of Sciences, I. Javakhishvili Tbilisi State University, Georgian Technical University and Georgian Mathematical Union (co-organizers: A. Razmadze Mathematical Institute, I. Vekua Institute of Applied Mathematics, N. Muskhelishvili Institute of Computational Mathematics, and Georgian Mechanical Union). The conference is sponsored by the Shota Rustaveli Foundation.

The event will start at approximately 4pm on September 9 by a Jubilee meeting at the Rustaveli Theater (to be confirmed). The International Conference "CONTINUUM MECHANICS AND RELATED PROBLEMS OF ANALYSIS" dedicated to N. Muskhelishvili will start next morning and will end in the evening of September 13. A one-day excursion to Kakheti region is planned for September 11.

- 3. We suggest that you book your hotel by July 5, Tuesday; otherwise the hotels with moderate prices might be already booked out. We would appreciate if you could inform us about your arrival and departure dates and accompanying persons, if any.
- 4. If you intend to publish an abstract in the Conference Book of Abstracts, **please submit a** LaTeX file by the **end of July**. You can download the abstract template file from the conference web or we can send it to you upon request.
- 5. Please arrange a valid **health insurance** for Georgia. If necessary, we can help you to purchase a health insurance covering emergency treatment for 1 Euro a day per person. Please let us know if you would like us to send you information on this insurance prior to your departure.
- 6. We can offer financial support to a limited number of participants to cover their accommodation expenses during the conference; please let us know if you wish to be considered.
- 7. Please let us know if you have difficulties with transferring the **conference fee** of **100 Euros** (**130 Euros from August 1**). There is no conference fee for accompanying persons, but they will need to pay for lunches, Conference Dinner and excursions. We will send an **Invoice** to all participants **by July 15**.
- 8. Please let us know if you need a **formal invitation letter** and we will e-mail you a scanned version.
